For the 2010-11 ice hockey season, the Santa Rosa Junior Hockey Club is again proud to sponsor the Cardinal Newman JV ice hockey team. The HP High School Hockey League consists of two separate divisions: Junior Varsity and Varsity. Unlike traditional high school sports where JV and Varsity are determined by age, high school hockey divisions are formed based on skill level. The JV division is made up of recreational, in-house and younger travel players, while the Varsity division is comprised of older and higher-end travel players, and tier players.

In order to participate in a Cardinal Newman team, a player must be currently enrolled in high school in Northern California, meet all California Interscholastic Federation guidelines, provide their own HECC approved ice hockey equipment and be current on all SRJHC financial obligations. Note that players may attend any high school, not only Cardinal Newman.

JV tryouts are scheduled for late August at Snoopy's Home Ice in Santa Rosa. Please see the Santa Rosa Junior Hockey Club's website at www.santarosaflyers.org for the latest schedule and exact tryout times.

JV practices will take place at Snoopy's Home Ice starting in late August/early September. Regular season games begin in November and run until February, with playoffs running into late March. Most games will take place at Sharks Ice in San Jose or at the Oakland Ice Center. Games generally take place on weekends; however there may be some mid-week games later in the season and during playoffs. We plan on participating in exhibition games prior to the start of the HP season, and attending a high school tournament in Klamath Falls Oregon over the 2011 MLK weekend (tournaments not included in dues).
