The Cardinal Newman Hockey Development Camp is intended for players from ages 13-20 and will be limited to a maximum of 30 skaters and 4 goalies. This unique camp offers a fun, week-long experience with an emphasis on Skating Technique, Puck Control, Passing, Proper Body Contact and Skill Development. Campers will participate in:

- On Ice sessions to focus on player skill development and team concepts
- Classroom sessions with topics such as Nutrition, Training, College and Junior Hockey Opportunities, etc...
- Dry Land Sessions to improve player athleticism, conditioning and confidence

### **Location: 1667 W. Steele Lane, Santa Rosa, CA**

Drop off and pickup will be at the Snoopy's Home Ice box office lobby. Players and instructors will gather at the box office prior to going to their camp activities. Locker Rooms will be assigned for the on ice sessions. Dry Land sessions will take place at the softball field area on Hardies Lane across from Snoopy's Home Ice.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Q. Who can participate?**

A. The camp is open to all players with birth years ranging from 1991-1998.

### **Q. What do I need to bring?**

A. All players will need to bring full ice hockey equipment and a water bottle. As well, players are encouraged to bring athletic shorts or pants, a t-shirt and tennis shoes for the dry land conditioning sessions. Players should also bring a snack or meal to be consumed in between the dry land training and on ice activities such as a sandwich, fruit, etc.

### **Q. What forms are required?**

A. All participants must submit the following forms to participate:

1. CN Hockey Development Camp Registration Form with signed waiver
2. Copy of current USA Hockey Registration for 2010-2011 season

### **Q. Who are the Instructors?**

A. The Camp will be led by the Coaching staff of the ECHL's Stockton Thunder. Head Coach Matt Thomas and Assistant Coach Matt O'Dette will also be joined by Cardinal Newman Head Coach Mike Kovanis.

### **Q. How do I pay for the Camp?**
